1. General description

The 74ABT16245B is a 16-bit transceiver with 3-state outputs. The device can be used as two 8-bit transceivers or one 16-bit transceiver. The device features two output enables (1OE and 2OE) each controlling eight outputs, and two send/receive (1DIR and 2DIR) inputs for direction control. A HIGH on nOE causes the outputs to assume a high-impedance OFF-state. This device is fully specified for partial power down applications using I_{OFF}. The I_{OFF} circuitry disables the output, preventing the potentially damaging backflow current through the device when it is powered down.

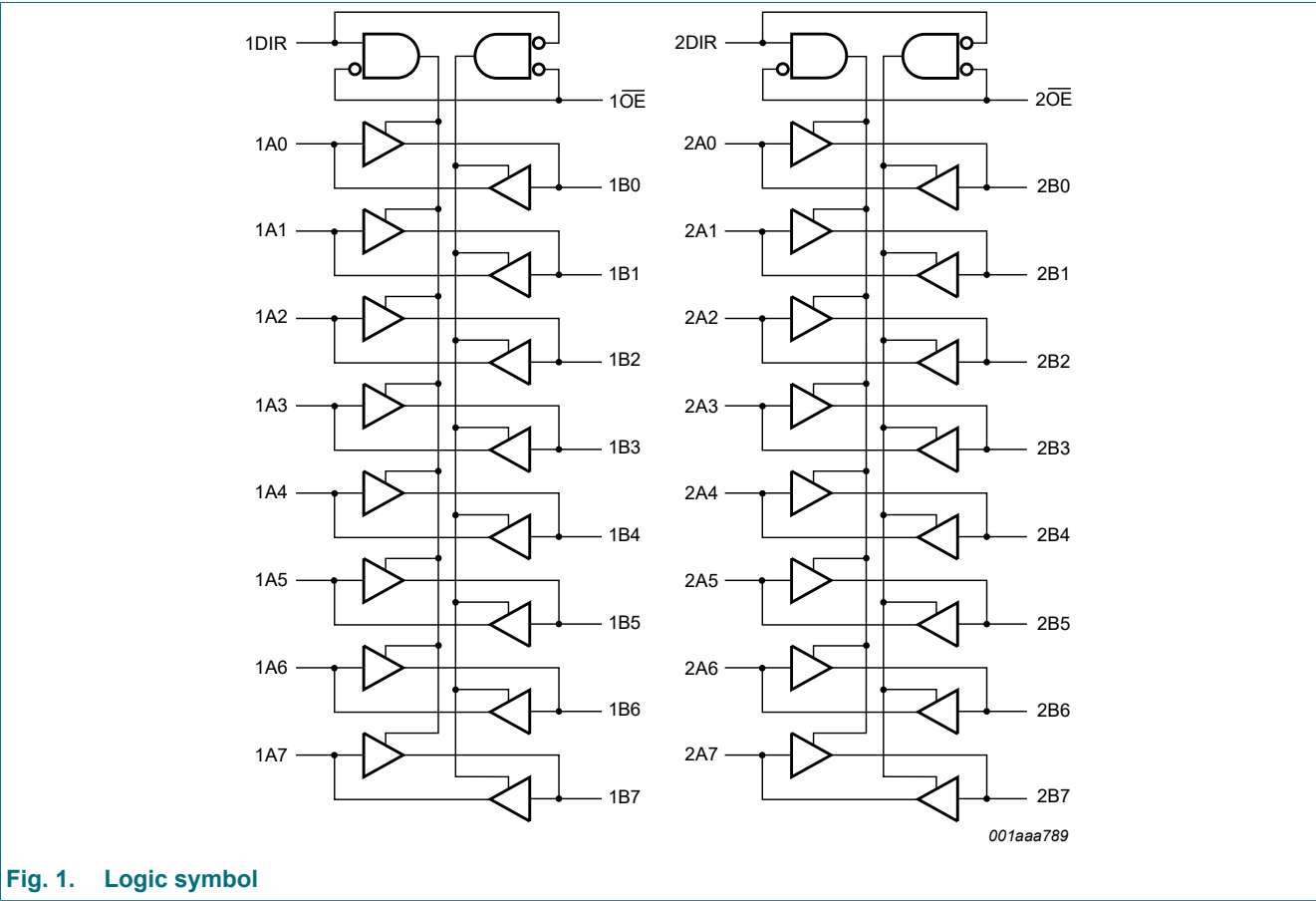

- Multiple V_{CC} and GND pins minimize switching noise
- Power-up 3-state
- 3-state buffers
- Output capability: +64 mA and -32 mA
- Live insertion/extraction permitted
- I_{OFF} circuitry provides partial Power-down mode operation
- Latch-up performance exceeds 500 mA per JESD 78 Class II Level B
- ESD protection:
 - HBM: ANSI/ESDA/JEDEC JS-001 class 2 exceeds 2000 V
 - CDM: ANSI/ESDA/JEDEC JS-002 class C3 exceeds 1000 V
- Specified from -40 °C to 85 °C

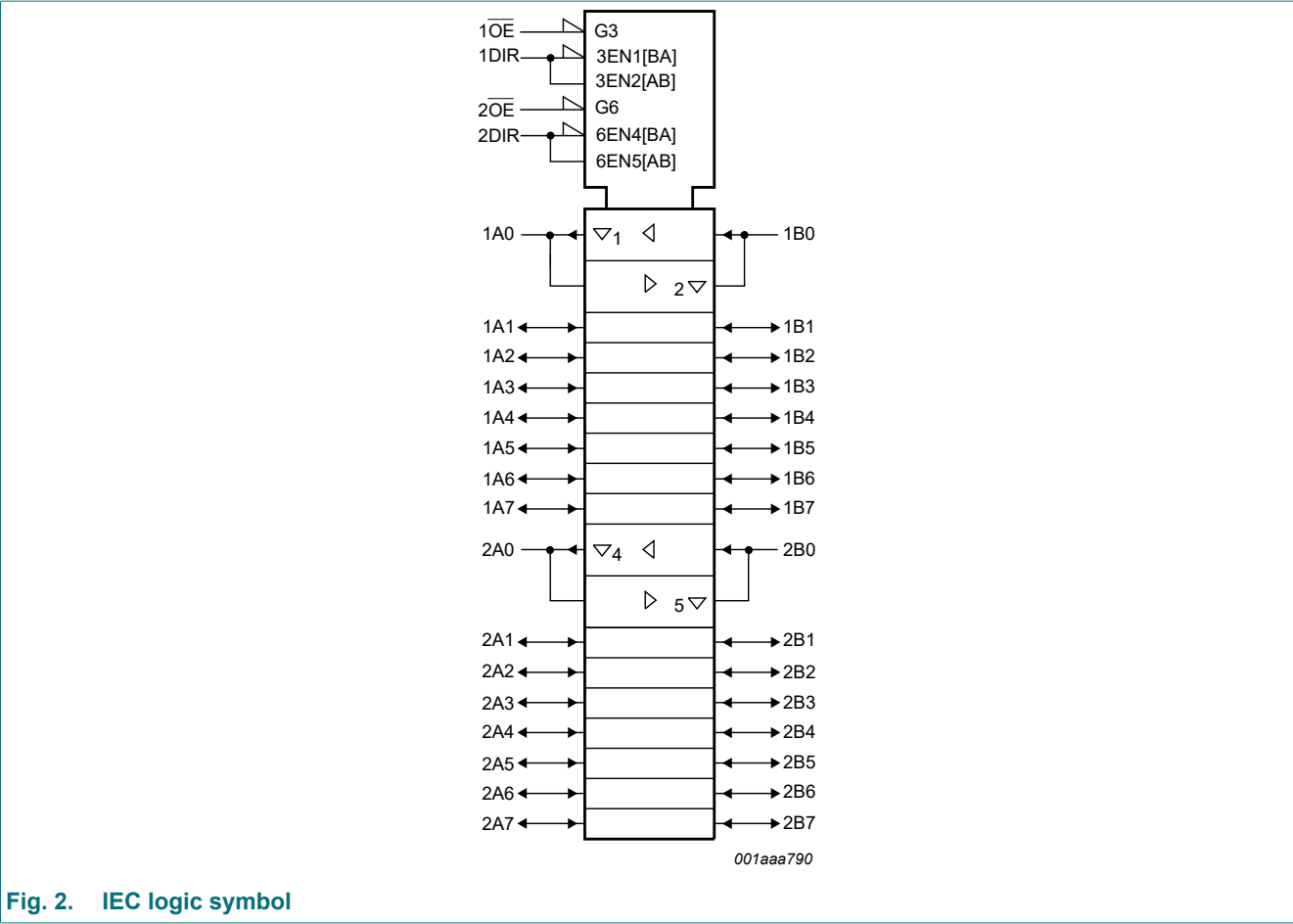

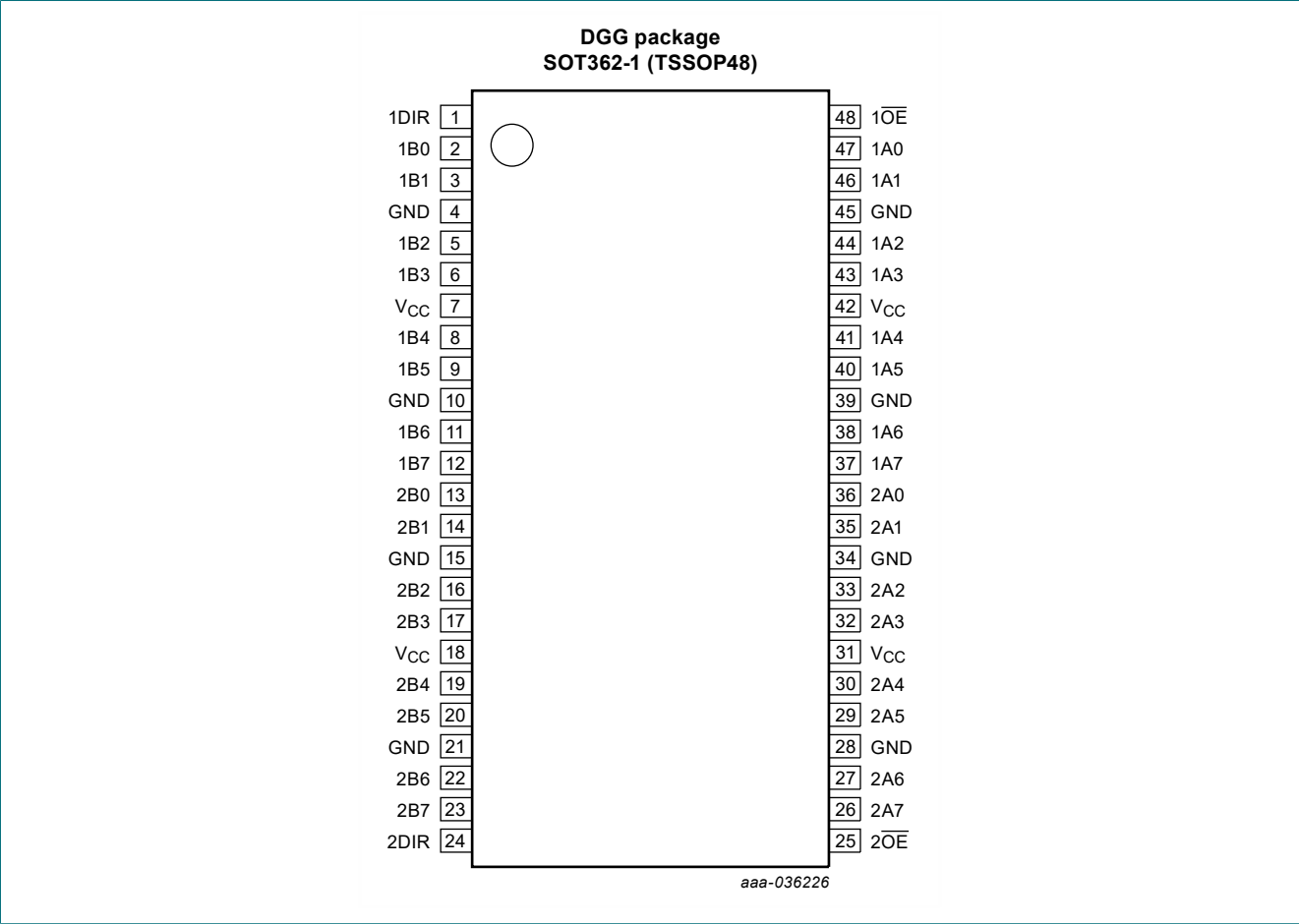

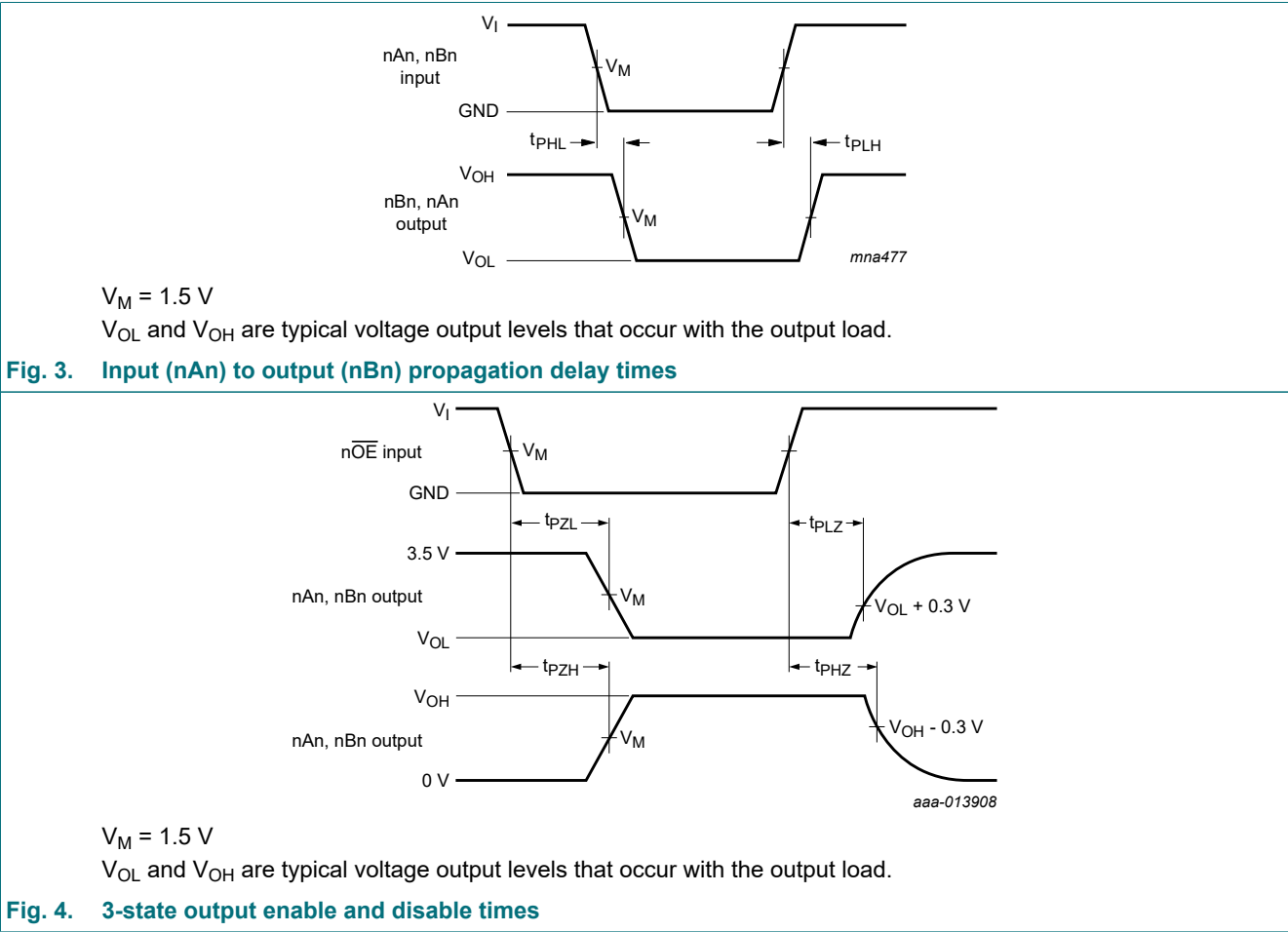

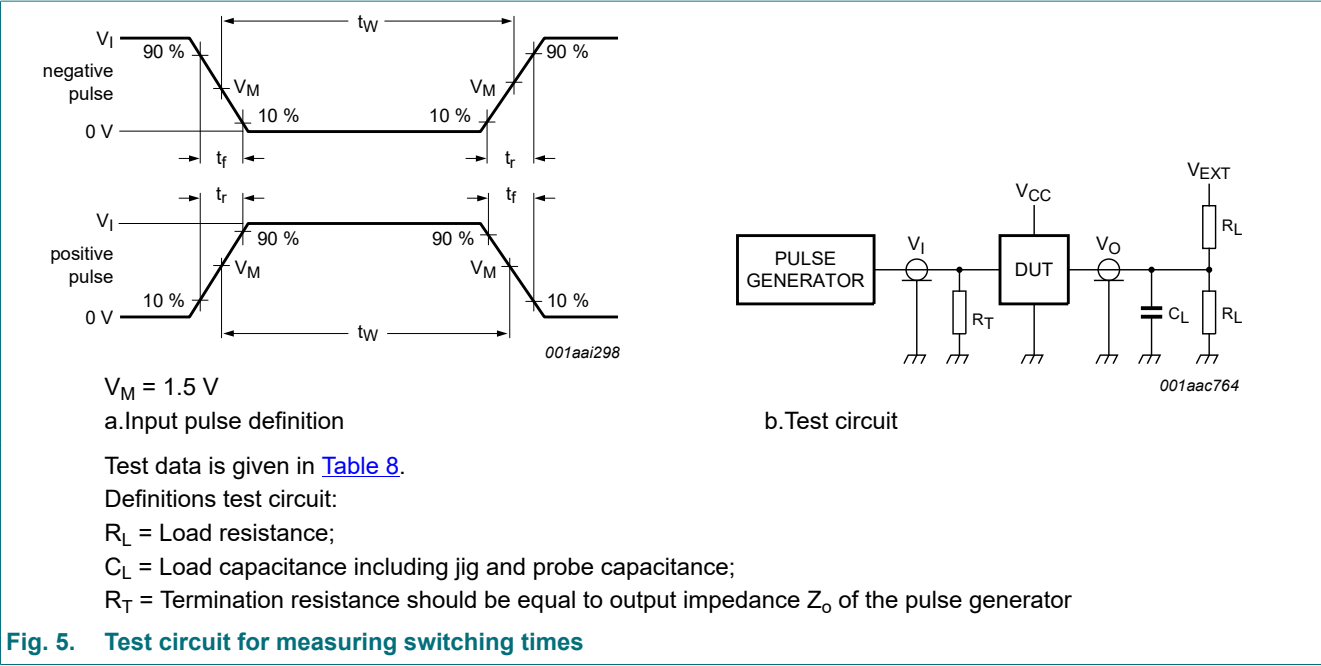


Fig. 5. Test circuit for measuring switching times

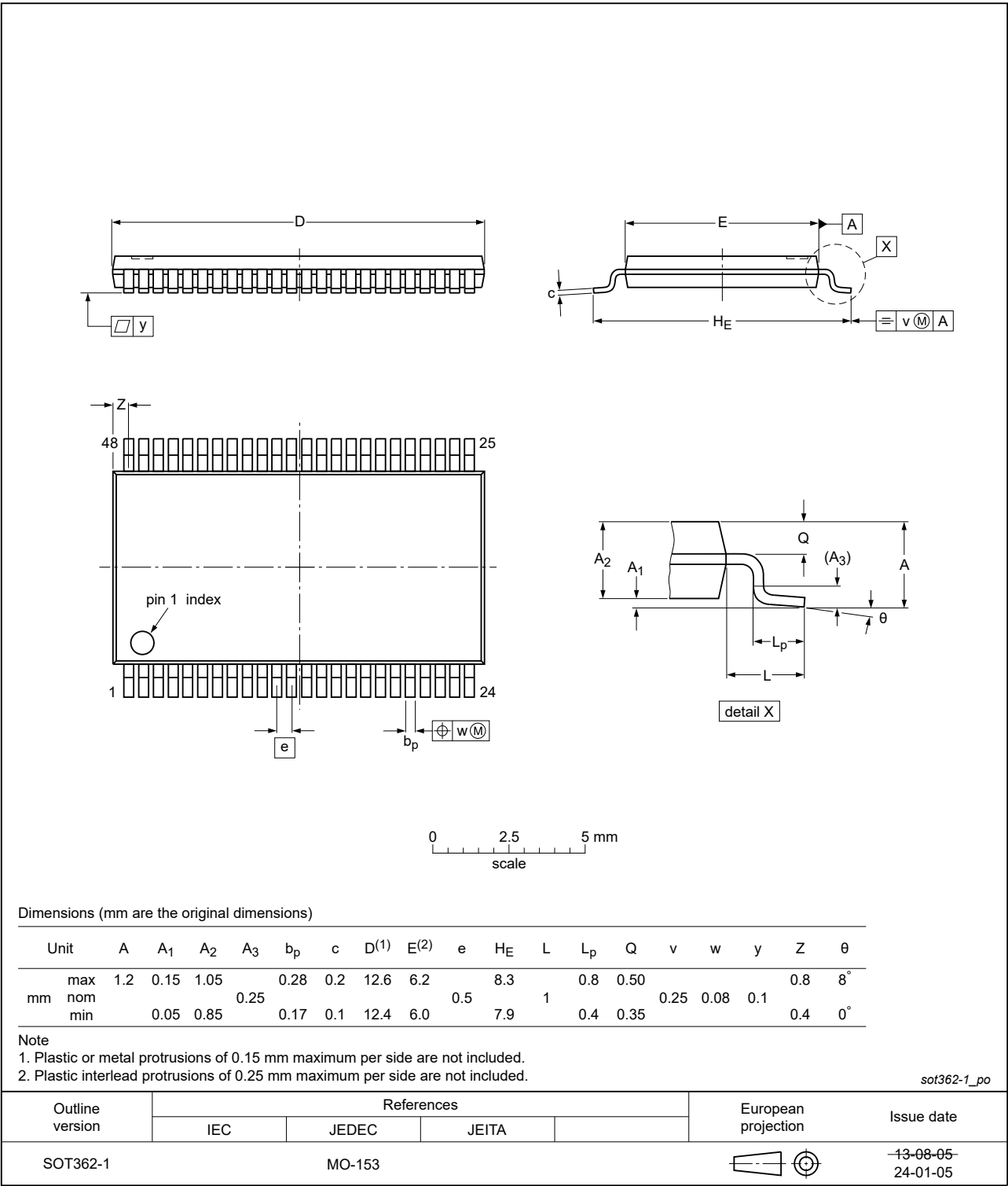


Fig. 6. Package outline SOT362-1 (TSSOP48)
